2021 Little Miss Pana Tri-County Fair Pageant General Rules

- 1. Contestant must be a U.S. Citizen and have been a resident of Christian, Shelby, or Montgomery County, IL for 6 months prior to pageant date. Must be a resident date of Pageant. Must not have Won a County Crown, for age division.
- 2. Contestant must be 4-6 years of age by the pageant date.
- 3. Contestant agrees to be interviewed on stage by our current Pana Tri-County Queen.
- 4. This will be a judged contest. Contestants are encouraged to dress age appropriately.

 For comfort of the participant and a huge help to the volunteers please refrain from wearing any dress that needs a hoop. Please make sure straps fit properly. Ultimately the goal is for your child to feel great in what they are wearing and to concentrate on what they need to do.
- 5. No make-up is allowed at this age level. (Neutral lip gloss/ chap stick is approved)
- 6. All the Contestants **MUST** sell **\$200** in 50/50 Tickets. There will be a 1st place top seller. Top seller are selected based on Money not Tickets. Also, If you sell \$300 in tickets you will get your Registration of \$25 refunded to you!
- 7. All practices and rehearsals are strongly encouraged. Final Rehearsal is required.
- 8. The new LITTLE MISS will be encouraged to attend the rest of the week's fair activities.
- 9. The newly selected LITTLE MISS will serve as hostess for the week of Pana Tri-County Fair.
- 10. Attendance at local parades and pageant are encouraged but not mandatory. All travel and securing a vehicle for any parade will be the parent's responsibility.
- 11. Please keep pageant/fair drama (from contestant or parents/guardians) off social media. No bashing of any kind on any social media. If this becomes apparent the contestant will be disqualified; if new reign has already taken place, she will relinquish her sash, crown, and ALL PRIZES upon the direction of the Pageant Director. The first runner-up will then be eligible for the title. If you can't say something nice, don't say anything at all!!!!
- 12. The decision of the judge is Final.
- 14. **HAVE FUN!!!!!** This is what pageants are all about!!...In the end there is only 1 winner and LOTS & LOTS of NEW FRIENDS!!!! Please encourage good sportsmanship!
